Nakala ya Hati ya Kuweka huru watumwa wa Afrika
Mashariki iliyokuwa inatolewa na wajerumani.



Maria Ernestina alikamatwa na mama yake na wafanabishara ya watumwa mwaka 1890 katika upande wa Mashariki wa Jamhuri ya Kidemokrasia ya Kongo. Wakati wa safari kuukenesha Bagamoyo mama yake alifariki njiani kwa sababu ya uchovu wa safari.

Msafara ulipofika Bagamoyo; watumwa wote wakawekwa huru na Wajerumani kwa sababu biashara hiyo ilikuwa imekwisha katazwa. Mchana huyu akaishi katika familia ya Kijerumani mwanzoni, lakini baadae akakimbilia Misionari Katoliki akawa analelewa na Masisa.

Mwaka 1910 Maria Ernestina aliolewa na Bwana Joseph Maganga, lakini Joseph alikawa ni mgonjwa wa ukoma hivyo alifariki mwaka 1919. Mwaka 1925 aliolewa tena na Bwana Victor Kitiza, lakini hawakubahatika kupata watoto. Tarehe 8 Desemba 1974 alaga dunia akiwa na umri wa zaidi ya miaka 85, akawa ni mtumwa wa mwisho aliyelelewa na Wamisionari Wakatoliki hapa Bagamoyo.

Maria Ernestina was captured with her mother by the slave traders in 1890 in the Eastern Republic Democratic of Congo and both taken to the Swahili Coast. Her mother died on their long walk to Bagamoyo.

When the caravan arrived in Bagamoyo, slave trade was abolished and the German authorities were in power. The young girl was given to the care of the German family, but she ran away to the Catholic Mission and was educated by the sisters.

In 1910, she married Joseph Maganga, but Maganga was a leper and died in 1919. In 1925 married with Victor Kitiza but they did not have children. On 8th of December 1974 she died in a very great ages of about 85 years old and she was the last known ex-slave who was given care by the Catholic Missionaries in Bagamoyo.

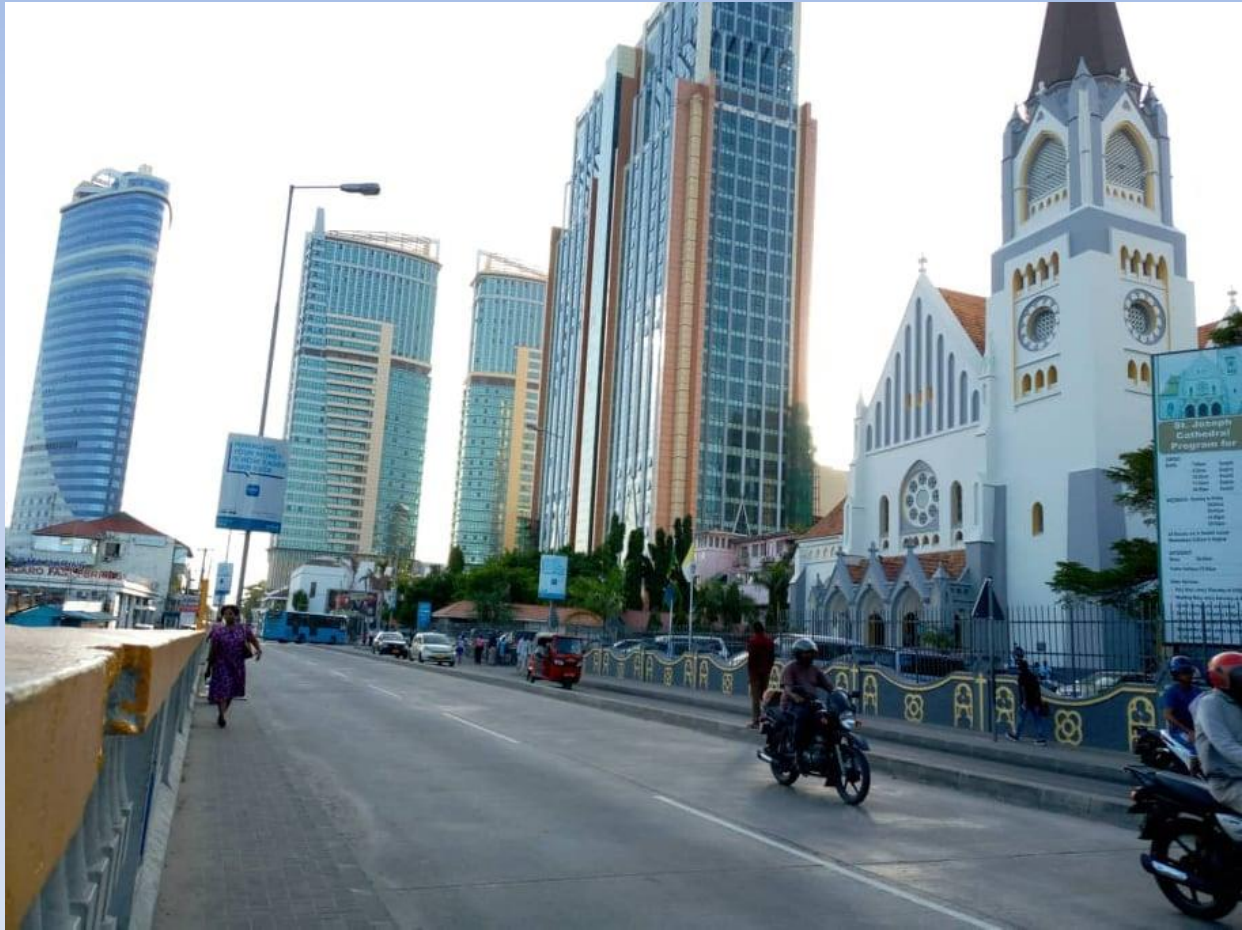
